JICA's Plan



Pilot Project at SRGC, Muzaffarnagar

The problem which is general in entire India, is of malfunctions and shortage of sewage treatment systems as well as increase in waterborne infections. Trillion litres of water got wasted due to the same. SRGC approached JICA (Japan International Cooperation Agency) for the solution of this problem. JICA funded the project and given the task to Japanese company Taisei Kougyou. It was the first pilot project in India in February 2020 with construction and execution of a Japanese decentralized wastewater treatment technology called Taisei Soil System (TSS) at the campus of Shri Ram Group of Colleges, Muzaffarnagar for the dissemination of waste water of student dormitory. Taisei Kougyou Co. Ltd. is a leading decentralized wastewater treatment company in Japan which has installed its Taisei Soil System (TSS) at Shri Ram Group of Colleges in association with three major companies namely, Original Engineering Consultants, Japan Environmental Sanitation Centre and E-Square at SRGC. Muzaffarnagar campus.

This project funded by the Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA). Technology and Action for Rural Advancement (TARA) - a social enterprise of the Development Alternatives' Group has coordinated between the Indian and Japanese counterparts.

- 1. The System of the project treated the wastewater by aerobic treatment in the soil absorption field.
- 2. The system , installed underground. Consequently, the top surface area was available for plantation. The iplants absorbed water from the soil absorption field.
- 98% or more reduction was there of Biological Oxygen Demand (BOD).
- 4. The system handled large load variations hence proved suitable for Indian scenario.
- 5. Under the project, not only is the construction of treatment facility targeted, time and budget resources were also allocated for awareness activities so that people use these, with emphasis placed on the diffusion and maintenance of "toilets that are actually used" in households, schools, and communities. An increase in sanitation awareness for families and local residents is expected through the provision of hygiene education.

About Seminar

An International Seminar on "Waste water management in India: Special reference to pilot project of TSS technology" is being organized under JICA(Japan)-SRGC(India) collaboration on Wednesday, 21st 2023 by Taisei Kougyou Co. Ltd. as principal company in association with three major companies as Original Engineering Consultants, Japan Environmental Sanitation Centre and E-Square to share the results of on-site Waste Water treatment pilot project at SRGC, Muzaffarnagar campus.



TSS makes use of Taisei Kougyou's proprietary "Tafgard" technology for on -site treatment of wastewater. It operates without electricity, easy to maintain and ideal for preventing environment pollution in locations, without any discharge of waste.

The seminar will focus on the results of Taisei Kougyou's pilot installation at one of the students' dormitories of Shri Ram Group of colleges and will highlight the contribution TSS can give towards India's national mission of advance sanitation and hygiene.
