A) About Shri Ram College of Law

Shri Ram College of Law, Muzaffarnagar, a distinguished constituent institution of the Shri Ram Group of Colleges, Muzaffarnagar, Uttar Pradesh, was established in 2004 with a commitment to providing quality legal education and nurturing competent, ethical, and socially responsible legal professionals.

At Shri Ram College of Law, legal education extends beyond the traditional classroom. The institution encourages intellectual inquiry, critical thinking, and academic dialogue, enabling students to engage meaningfully with contemporary legal and constitutional issues. Students are regularly exposed to a vibrant academic environment through seminars, workshops, and interactions with distinguished members of the legal fraternity, including eminent judges, advocates, and legal scholars. The College also promotes academic discussion on emerging legal challenges at the national and global levels, and provides practical exposure through moot court activities, mock trials, legal aid clinics, and engagements with the District Legal Services Authority for experiential learning and practical skill development.

B) Introduction: -

Research is an essential aspect of higher education. It is a vital process which acts as the bedrock for intellectual development, knowledge creation and evidence-based decision making. We are at the precipice of marked socio-economic and technical shifts on a global scale, with the advent of machine learning and AI, changing weather patterns and climate change, increased use of ICTs in education etc; the concept of "RESEARCH" has become ever so important.

First step for developing a holistic culture of multidisciplinary research is training early career faculty members, researchers, Ph.D. scholars and post graduate students. The importance of research focussed faculty cannot be overstated. Faculty adept in research methodology has the capability to apply theoretical concepts in real life practical scenarios. Such an approach empowers faculty members to provide high quality educational experiences. To meet the needs of modern students equipped with modern technologies innovative teaching has become the norm.

From the perspective of an academician, research is not just about delivering innovative lectures; it is also an important tool for career progression. The increasing demand of contemporary interdisciplinary research often requires research scholars to move beyond traditional disciplinary boundaries and engage in social, legal and scientific dimensions.

Expansion in digital technologies creates new opportunities as well as challenges for early faculty members. On one hand there are new publication opportunities, exciting prospects of interdisciplinary research but on the other there are grave issues such as data manipulation, plagiarism, weak research methodology and improper citation etc.

Many faculty members, research scholars and post graduate students possess promising research ideas but often require structured guidance in transforming those ideas into methodologically sound high quality academic research work. The proposed workshop seeks to address these needs through a focused and interdisciplinary academic programme.

C) Pedagogical framework of the Workshop: -

Traditional teaching methodology is usually characterised by unidirectional flow of information from teacher to students. This approach turns participants into passive learners, which essentially reduces learning capabilities.

The present workshop uses **Four Quadrant approach** designed to create a comprehensive learning experience. It will be conducted in hybrid mode bringing together resource persons from legal, academic and scientific backgrounds.

Each session follows the Four Quadrant Approach highlighted below-

Quadrant I- Lecture of expert resource person.

Quadrant II- Reading materials involving case studies, articles and other relevant supplementary materials.

Quadrant III- As part of interactive and collaborative learning experience -

- i) Short doubt clearing session with the resource person at the end of each lecture.
- ii) To further augment the learning experience there will be an innovative practical academic exercise with the faculty co-ordinator of the workshop every day.

Quadrant IV- Self assessment exercises in the form of quizzes, tests etc.

D) Objective of the Workshop: -

National Workshop on Research Methodology, Research Ethics and Publication Strategy is designed as research-oriented capacity building initiative for participants from diverse academic backgrounds with the following objectives-

- a) Strengthening conceptual understanding of research methodology and developing the habit of academic inquiry
- b) Capacity building of participants in identifying research problems, formulating research questions, determining the scope and limitations of the research.
- c) Highlight important aspects of doctrinal, empirical, comparative, qualitative, quantitative and multidisciplinary research approaches.
- d) Promoting research ethics, academic integrity and responsible use of artificial intelligence in academic research.
- e) Introducing primary tools and techniques of research including sampling, data collection, research instruments etc.
- f) Building publication preparedness of participants by underlining the importance of academic writing, article structure, journal selection and publication strategy.

E) Target Audience: -

The proposed workshop is intended for **faculty members, research scholars, postgraduate students, early-career researchers and participants from law, humanities, social sciences, commerce, management, education, science and allied disciplines.**

The interdisciplinary design of the workshop will enable participants from diverse academic streams to engage with common principles of research while also applying them to their respective disciplinary contexts.

F) Themes and academic exercises: -

The theme for each day of the workshop has been designed to inculcate essential aspects of research methodology in a progressive manner. Starting with the foundations of research methodology, research design, different types of research methodologies, ethics, AI, data collection and ending with academic writing, Journal selection and publication strategy.

Each day of the workshop will include a short academic exercise designed to translate the theme of the session into practical learning experience. These exercises will be simple, discipline neutral and output oriented, so that participants from diverse academic backgrounds can meaningfully participate.

Academic Integrity in Research and Publication: Ethical and Legal Issues

Research Methods: Tools, Techniques, Sampling and Data Collection

Academic Writing, Journal Selection and Publication Strategy

SPSS for Researchers: Data Analysis, Interpretation and Reporting

G) Nature, Mode and Platform: -

The workshop will be organized in online mode. Sessions will be delivered by invited resource persons from reputed universities and colleges such as National Forensic Science University, Delhi University, Amity University, Chaudhary Charan Singh University etc with expertise in research methodology, legal research, research ethics etc.

The live sessions will be conducted through Microsoft Teams/ Google Meet. Google classroom will be used for coordination, sharing of session links, study material, attendance forms, academic exercises, announcements and workshop related communications.

Each session will be of **45- 50 minutes**. There will be an additional **10 – 15 minutes** for Q/A session with the Expert Resource person, followed by a session of academic exercises with faculty co-ordinator.

H) Certificate of participation: -

Certificate of participation will be issued only to registered participants who have attended at least 5 sessions, submitted required academic exercises and self-assessment drills/learning outcomes.

I) Registration Fees: -

Online participants will be charged a nominal fee of **₹500/- only**. Fee will include access to online sessions, workshop materials and certificate of completion, subject to fulfilment of attendance, academic exercises and self- assessments.

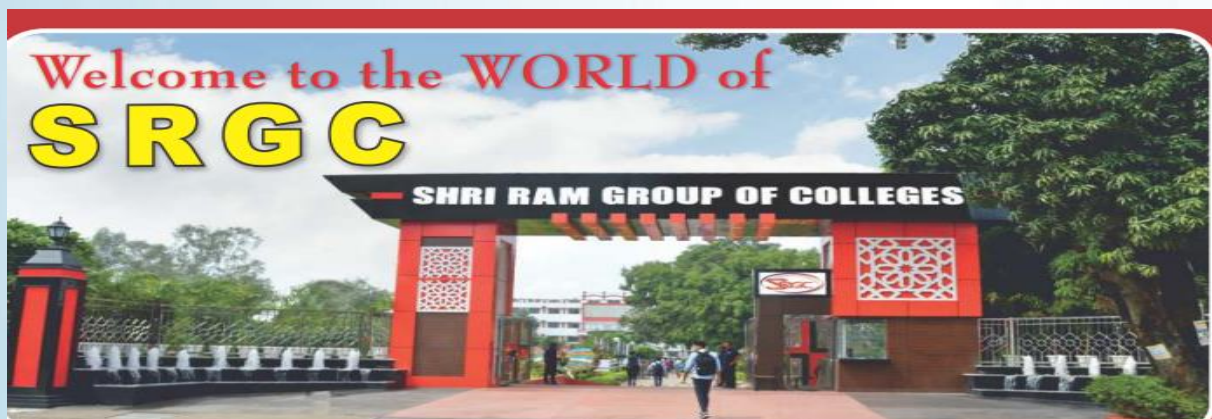
